Training:

-BP is offering a free computer based wildlife recovery course. To register call **866-647-2338**.

-OSHA is offering a 24-hour hazardous material training course for the purpose of stopping, containing, controlling and cleaning up the oil release. The cost is \$575 per person. Also being offered is a 4 hour course designed to address safety and health awareness for crude oil exposures. The cost is \$100 per person.
